Event Title: Oral Cancer Awareness Program

OUTCOME: The Oral Cancer Awareness Program, held on the morning of February 25, 2025, at Komuru, was a significant part of the day's main celebration. Organized by the Department of Oral Pathology and Microbiology and coordinated by Dr. B.
