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Memorandum of understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MoU") made on this 20th day of November, 2024.

Between

St. Joseph Dental College (SJDC) which is run by VDMC trust and falls under the Eluru diocese of Catholic Church of India, Situated at Duggirala, Pedavegi mandal, Eluru, Andra pradesh represented by its Principal, Dr. N.Sleeva Raju.

And

Sir C.R.Reddy College of Pharmaceutical Sciences a registered Institute and having its registered office at, Santhi Nagar, GNT Road, Eluru, Andhra Pradesh – 534007 which is represented by its principal here in **Dr. A. Narendra Babu**.

Preamble:

- A. St. Joseph Dental college, Eluru, a leading dental institution dedicated to advancing academic excellence, pioneering Innovative research, and sharing knowledge through scholary publications in health care and Dentistry.
- B. It is our everlasting passion that has helped us train our undergraduate and postgraduate students with unsurpassed skills in clinical, Academic and Research domains. We believe that our ultimate success would be to see our students become strong confident successful professionals.
- C. St. Joseph Dental College and Sir C.R.Reddy College of Pharmaceutical Sciences recognizing the mutual benefits of collaboration, seek to establish a formal



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understanding of cooperation. This MOU aims to enhance the academic goals of both parties & foster a culture of quality educational services, Research excellence, and professional development among faculty members & students of both parties.

The purpose of this MOU is to:

- 1.1. To promote and enhance academic interest between St. Joseph Dental College, Eluru and the Sir C.R.Reddy College of Pharmaceutical Sciences recognizing by exchange of information on research and educational programmes.
- 1.2. To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- 1.3. To jointly organize short-term continuing education programmes on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty and students to participate therein in such joint programs.
- 1.4. To jointly organize, or have participation of the other Party in, seminars, conferences, or workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty and students to participate therein in such joint programs.
- 1.5. To invite other Party's faculty and students to participate in the respective Party's seminars, conferences, or workshops.
- 1.6. To jointly propose and engage in research or training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, and to invite each other's faculty and students to participate therein in such programs.
- 1.7. To exchange, on a reciprocal basis, students at Undergraduate, Graduate and Doctoral levels for limited periods of time for purpose of education and /or research.
- 1.8. To exchange and have participation of each other's students or faculty on a clerkship or observer ship basis.



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SCOPE OF MOU

- Training for Faculty through various Faculty Development Programs: A Party
 may train the other Party's faculty through workshops, seminars,
 conferences, and training sessions, curriculum development, assessment
 methods, technology integration, research methodologies, etc. The
 objective is to enhance the teaching effectiveness, research capabilities, and
 professional growth of educators.
 - 2. Research Projects in respective institutions: Both the Parties can collaborate and help each other on research projects conducted within their respective premises, subject to prior approval from the Institutional Ethical Committee. It would help identify and invite faculty members and students from the other institution to participate in research or development programmes. The terms and conditions for such participation will be worked out by mutual agreement between the Parties.
 - 3. Conducting mutually beneficial workshops, seminars, and educational events: Both Parties can collaborate and organize workshops, seminars, and educational events that cater to the academic needs and interests of students and faculty members of both the Parties. Parties shall collaborate and invite faculty and students to participate in any existing workshops, seminars, and educational events. The terms and conditions of such participation shall be worked out by mutual agreement between the Parties.
 - Research collaboration on antibacterial substance formulation: the faculties
 can involve in research collaboration on nanoparticles or any antibacterial
 formulation: its synthesis, characterization and incorporation of
 nanoparticles in dental materials and as antibacterial agents.
 - 5. <u>Synthesis of pharmaceutical products involved in dentistry</u>: the products like toothpaste, mouthwash, astringent, remineralizing agent etc can be formulated with collaborative involvement of faculties of both institutions.



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Budget: The expenses associated with conducting the research project will be borne by the institution proposing the project. Funding for the research will be sought from various external agencies. In cases where a postgraduate student from St. Joseph Dental College collaborates with Sir C.R. Reddy College of Pharmaceutical Sciences for formulation synthesis or characterization, the associated costs of the collaborative activities will be the responsibility of the postgraduate student from St. Joseph Dental College.

This MOU is valid for a period of 1 year from the date of coming into force from the date of signing.

This MOU represents the good faith and understanding of the Parties to proceed further with the proposed academic collaboration, and each of the Parties shall do all things reasonably within its power which are necessary or desirable to give effect to the spirit and intent of this MOU
