ORDER:

In the G.O. 2nd read above, Government have issued certain guidelines for affiliation of Private Dental Colleges to Government Medical Colleges for training of their students for a maximum period of one year subject to certain conditions imposed in para (5) therein.

2. In the G.O. 3rd read above, Government have permitted M/s. C.V.S. Krishna Murthy Teja Charities for utilisation of S.V. Medical College facilities at Tirupathi subject to the conditions in 3 in the G.O. 2nd read above.

3. In the representation 3rd read above, M/s. C.V.S. Krishna Murthy Teja Charities have represented -

- i) to exempt them from payment of fee of Rs. 15,000/- in respect of students admitted against free seats, since the said fee is more than the tuition fee of Rs. 8,000/- prescribed by the Government for the students admitted against free seats.
 - ii) to reduce the fee of Rs. 15,000/- to Rs. 8,000/- in respect of students admitted against payment seats, since they have to spend considerable amount for payment of salaries and maintenance of the college being newly established college.
 - iii) to allow for training of students in S.V. Medical College for a period of three years instead of one year.
4. The request of M/s. C.V.S. Krishna Murthy Teja Charities has been referred to the Committee constituted in the G.O. 2nd read

above for the purpose. The Committee have recommended as follows:

5. Government after careful examination of the matter accept the above recommendations of the Committee and hereby issue the following amendments to G.O.Ms.No.212, H.M. & F.W. (El) Department, dt.23.6.2000.

AMENDMENT - I

For the words "one year" occurring in Para-5(1) of G.O.Ms.No.212, H.M.&F.W. (El) Department, dt.23.6.2000 shall be read as "three years".

AMENDMENT - II

For the words "the Private Dental Colleges shall pay an amount of U.S.15,000/- for each student" occurring in condition (2) of Para-5 of G.O.Ms.No.212, H.M.&F.W. (El) Department, dt.23.6.2000, the following shall be substituted:

- "The Private Dental Colleges shall pay the following fees for utilisation of Govt. Medical College facilities -
- for all free seats U.S.1,000/- p.a. per student
 - for all payment seats U.S.10,000/- p.a. per student.
 - for NEI seats U.S.25,000/- p.a. per student.

AMENDMENT - III

For existing condition (6) of Para-5 of G.O.Ms.No.212, H.M. and F.W. (El) Department, dt.23.6.2000, the following condition shall be substituted:

- (6) The revised fee as referred to in condition-2 of Para-5 above to be paid by the Private Dental Colleges shall be credited to the Account of Hospital Development Society of the concerned Medical College to be utilised for its development. The Heads of Departments shall render annual accounts.

ORDER:-

In the G.O.1st, 3rd and 4th read above, Government have issued certain guidelines and conditions for grant of permission for utilization/ attachment/ affiliation of Government Hospital facilities to the Private Dental Colleges for training of their students.

2. The issue of enhancing the fee for utilization of facilities in Government Colleges by the Private Dental Colleges has been examined. Accordingly, Government after careful examination of the matter have decided to increase the fees fixed for utilization of clinical facilities etc., from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.25,000/- per student-per each academic year, commensurating with the present day cost of the maintenance of the Government Hospitals, which would help improve the financial status of the Government Medical, Dental, Nursing and Paramedical courses seek to avail the clinical facilities with clinical affiliation. In modification of the earlier orders issued on the above subject in G.O.Ms.No.170, HM&FW (E1) Dept., dated 30.3.1999 as amended from time to time. The following amendment is issued to G.O.Ms.No.306, HM&FW (E1) Dept., dated 2.8.2001.

AMENDMENT

For the words "for all payment seats @ Rs.10,000/- per annum per student" occurring in condition (b) of Amendment-II in G.O.Ms.No.306, H.M.& F.W.(E1) Dept., dated 2.8.2001 the following shall be substituted:-

"(b) for all payment seats @ Rs.25,000/- per annum per student".
